COVID-19 Health Orders

WHEREAS, Section 4 of Health Order No. 2020-1 (Shelter in Place for COVID-19 Illness) provides:

“Section 4. This Order shall remain in effect until the Commissioner of Health makes a written determination that the threat to public health posed by COVID-19 has diminished to the point that this Order can be safely repealed.”

WHEREAS, Section 6 of Health Order No. 2020-5 (Cessation of Alcoholic Liquor Sales) provides:

“Section 6. This Order shall remain in effect until the Commissioner of Health makes a written determination that the threat to public health posed by COVID-19 has diminished to the point that this Order can be safely repealed.”

WHEREAS, Section 4 of Health Order No. 2020-6 (Information Regarding COVID-19 Testing Facilities) provides:

“Section 4. This Order shall remain in effect until the Commissioner of Health makes a written determination that the threat to public health posed by COVID-19 has diminished to the point that this Order can be safely repealed.”

WHEREAS, Section 5 of Health Order No. 2020-7 (Reporting Requirements for Short Term Residential Rental Intermediaries) provides:

“Section 5. This Order shall remain in effect until the Commissioner of Health makes a written determination that the threat to public health posed by COVID-19 has diminished to the point that this Order can be safely repealed.”

WHEREAS, Section 8 of Health Order No. 2020-9 (Phase VI/Bridge Phase) provides:

“Section 8. This Order shall remain in effect until the Commissioner of Health makes a written determination that the threat to public health posed by COVID-19 has diminished to the point that this Order can be safely repealed.”

WHEREAS, Section 6 of Health Order No. 2020-10 (Quarantine Restrictions on Persons Entering Chicago from High Incidence States) provides:

“Section 6. This Order shall take effect at 12:01 a.m. on July 6, 2020 and shall remain in effect until the Commissioner of Health makes a written determination that the

threat to public health posed by COVID-19 has diminished to the point that this Order can be safely repealed.”

Now, therefore:

The undersigned has concluded that the above-listed Health Orders can safely be repealed, and, accordingly, appends her signature below.

The repeal of the above-listed Orders shall not in any way moot or otherwise affect the validity of any current administrative or enforcement proceedings based on any violation of any of those Orders to date.
