AMENDED MONTHLY RULE 45 REPORT
March, 2020

Pursuant to Rule 45 of the City Council Rules of Order, the Committee on Public Safety submits the following monthly report.

On Tuesday, March 10, 2020, at 10:01 a.m., the Committee on Public Safety called a meeting to order in City Hall, Room 201A, 121 North LaSalle Street, 2nd Floor.
