COMMITTEE ON COMMITTEES AND RULES MONTHLY RULE 45 REPORT JULY, 2020

On July 20, 2020, at 2:00 p.m. the Committee on Committees and Rules conducted a meeting by videoconference. There were 6 items on the agenda:

Item 1: the approval of the June 2020 Monthly Rule 45 Report for the Committee on Committee and Rules. Alderman Lopez moved to accept the approval of the June monthly report—motion was approved.

Item 2: O2020-333 correction of the City Council Journal of Proceedings of April 24, 2020. Alderman Reilly moved to recommend the approval of the journal correction—motion was approved.

Item 3: O2020-3449 the determination of the appropriate committee for re-referral of proposed ordinance that would amend Municipal Code Chapter 5-12 and 13-72 to further regulate requirements for just cause evictions, tenant relocation assistance and notice requirements for evictions and rental rate increases. Alderman Taliaferro moved to approve the re-referral of this ordinance to the Committee on Housing and Real Estate—motion was approved.

Item 4: direct introduction of proposed resolution regarding an advisory referendum question for the 2020 general election ballot concerning the creation of comprehensive development plan for the City of Chicago.

Eleanor Gorski from Department of Planning & Development testified. Jeff Levine clarified legal questions. Alderman Hadden, Alderman Vasquez, Alderman Martin and

Alderman Lopez commented. A roll call vote was taken to pass this resolution – there were 21 ‘yes’ votes and 15 ‘no’ votes. Resolution was passed.

Item 5: direct introduction of a proposed resolution regarding an advisory referendum question for the 2020 general election ballot concerning action to increase broadband internet in the City of Chicago. Alderman Cardenas is a co-sponsor of this resolution. Alderman Vaaquez, Hadden and Sigcho-Lopez made comments as well. Motion was made to approve the direct introduction—motion was passed by the same roll call vote as was applied to determine quorum with the exception of Alderman Lopez and Alderman Reilly who were a no vote. Resolution was passed.

Item 6: direct introduction of proposed resolution regarding an advisory referendum question for the 2020 general election ballot concerning restrictions in the sale or possession of certain firearms and magazines in the State of Illinois. Alderman Taliaferro is a co-sponsor of this resolution. Aldermen Smtih, Lopez and Mitts commented. Alderman Mitts moved to pass this resolution by the same roll call vote as was applied to determine quorum. Resolution was passed.

Alderman Scott moved to adjourn the meeting---meeting was adjourned.
